From the Admin Console of your Jive Community, navigate to System->Plugins- >Add Plugin menu. Click on Choose File, then open the file, smz-multidoc-plugin- 9.x.x.x-XX.jar, which you were provided with. Once selected, click Upload.

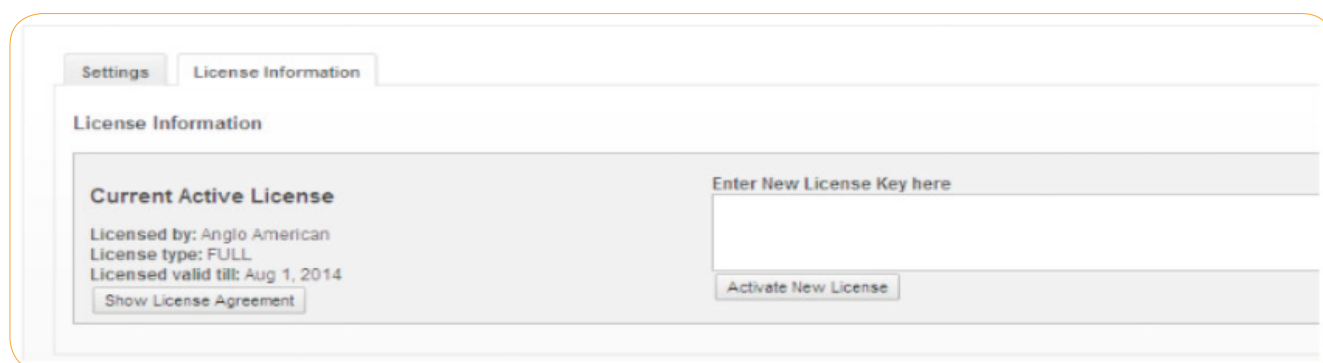


# INSTALLING THE PLUGIN

# COMMON PLUGIN SETTINGS

## SETTING

## DESCRIPTION

Enable Auto Translation	Makes the automatic translation functionality available to end-users.
Remember User Settings	Users can choose if they want content to be translated into their preferred language automatically or not. This setting specifies whether this preference is persistent between pages as the user navigates in Jive. Recommended settings <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Internal Communities: Enable</li><li>• External Communities: Disable</li></ul>
Auto Translate by default	Determines whether content is translated to the user's preferred language automatically when they open a page, or whether they need to switch the translations on manually.
Available Target Languages	The Translation Manager plugin integrates into the Jive search functionality. Search queries initiated by the user will be automatically translated into the list of languages provided here. E.g. if the list includes English and German, an English search query for "Social Media" would automatically search for "Social Media" and "Soziale Medien". This list takes a comma-separated list of language codes. E.g. en,es,de for English, Spanish and German
Translation Provider	Select the translation provider you have contracted with. Out of the box Google, Microsoft and Lionbridge are supported

GeoFluent Account Secret	The account secret provided to you by Lionbridge (Only visible to Lionbridge users)
Auto Redirect	This option controls whether the user will be automatically directed to the version of a document in their preferred language, if the document is available in their language.
